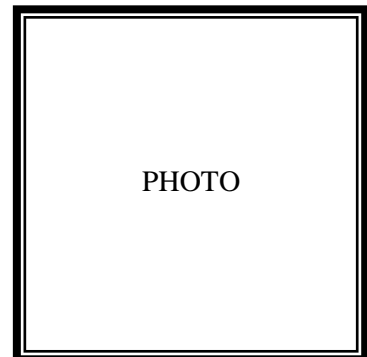

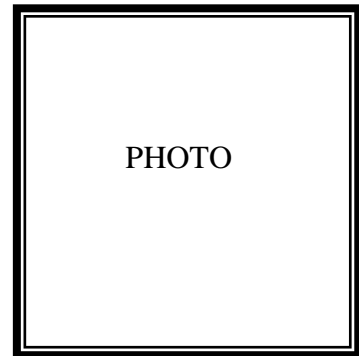

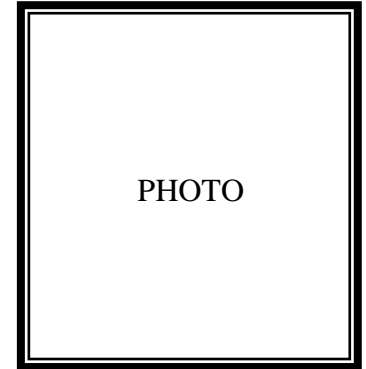

RULES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE CANDIDATES.**(To be issued to the students along with admit card)**

- 1- The examination will be held on the prescribed dates as per programme already notified. The doors will be opened on the first day half an hour before and on other days 15 minutes before the scheduled time.
- 2- A seat with his/her roll number will be allotted to each candidate. Candidates will be required to find and occupy the seats allotted to them
- 3- No candidate without the special permission of the Centre Superintendent should leave his/her seat of the examination room till the end of the examination.
- 4- During the course of examination, the candidates shall be under the discipline and control of the Centre Superintendent and shall obey all orders issued by the Superintendent on all matters relating to examination.
- 5- Urinals for the use of examinees shall be provided by centre and every examinee shall be required to use those urinals only.
- 6- Candidates should note carefully that, if questions required to be answered in separate answer book should be done so. If they fail to do so, question of only one section shall be examined and those of the other section will be treated as cancelled.
- 7- Where a candidate changes ink while he/she is answering a paper he/she should bring this fact to the notice of the invigilator on duty that will record this fact at the appropriate place and affix the Controller of Examinations facsimile stamp.
- 8- Candidates should note care fully, that it shall be deemed an offence amounting to cheating if they write answer to the same question more than once.
- 9- Candidates will be penalized to the extent of one mark per question if they do not number their answers correctly.
- 10- No candidate should leave any blank page in between any two answers in the answer-book, if a page or two is inadvertently left blank the letters "P.T.O." must invariably be written on that page or pages for the guidance of the examiner.
- 11- Candidates are advised not to write their Roll Numbers, Name or make any other Signs or marks inside their answer-book. Any breach of this instruction is liable to be penalized
- 12- Candidates should not leave the hall without handing over their answer-book to the invigilator-in-charge.
- 13- All candidates are required to bring their own pens and use blue ink only for answering their question paper. They should not bring any text book or notes with them in the Examination Hall, in which they are seated.
- 14- Candidates are forbidden from writing answers (or anything else) on the question paper.
- 15- **CANDIDATE SHOULD READ THE QUESTION PAPER AND THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE THEY BEGIN TO WRITE THEIR ANSWER.**
- 16- Attempt to use unfair means to pass the examination or any violation of the preceding rules or any personal approach to the examiner concerned will be subject to severe action. The candidate will be asked to submit his/her written statement in the printed Performa to be supplied by the Centre Superintendent in the examination hall before second answer-book is given to him/her for answering. If any examinee refuses to give his/her statement on the spot or runs away from the center, his/her case will be decided by the University in absentia on the report of Centre Superintendent and no representation or protest form his/her will be entertained afterwards.
- 17- A candidate found guilty of use of unfair means or disorderly conduct at or in connection with the examination or violation of the preceding rules or personal approach to the examiner concerned will be liable to severe action under the provisions. The candidate will be supplied with a copy of the charge sheet immediately after the examination when the paper is over and asked to submit his/her written reply on the charge sheet and also to sign the material recovered from his/her before leaving the Examination hall, and he / she will also be given personal hearing by the superintendent, if needed. If the candidate refuses to give his/her statement on the spot and or refuses to sign the Material recovered or leaves the centre without giving his/her statement or if he/she is guilty of showing disorderly conduct a notice will be sent to him/her under registered cover calling up on him/her to show cause why action should not be taken against him/her for using unfair means and or showing misconduct. Such cases will be decided by the University in absentia on the basis of the report of the Invigilator/Center Superintendent and the reply, if any, received from the candidate and no representation or protest from him/her will be entertained afterwards.
- 18- No enquiries by telegram or post concerning result will be answered by the Controller of Examinations, candidates must wait for the announcement of their result.
- 19- No guarantee is given to the candidates regarding the order of the question paper.
- 20- In case the original Admission card is lost, its duplicate copy may be issued on receipt of an application through proper channel along with a fee of Rs.10/-.
- 21- Candidates must write on both sides of the leaf in their answer-book. Any rough drafting or calculation etc. may be made and cross out. These will not be read by the examiner.
- 22- If candidate leave the examination hall before the expiry of two hours, he/she question paper he/she should leave it with the Superintendent and can take it from him/her at the end of the examination, Answer-book should be handed over to the invigilator-in-charge .
- 23- Candidates are required to answer the question paper in English only. They are not allowed to answer the question in any other language.
- 24- If a candidate(s) boy-cot(s) any paper/examination it shall be at his/her own risk. Complaints against question papers if any should be submitted to the University through the centre Superintendent concerned with in 24 hours from the date of the examination for the paper concerned, after which no complaint will be entertained. A committee will be constituted to look in to the grievances and take appropriate action.
- 25- Smoking and other intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall & Room.
- 26- The invigilators and the members of the flying squad are empowered to take search of the examinees during the examinations.
